

Who We Are

We are an international all-volunteer 501 (c)(3) non-profit organization. Our motto is "a union of those who love in the service of all that suffers."

The Theosophical Order of Service (TOS) was founded in 1908 by Annie Besant, a tireless social activist in England and India. She later served as international president of the Theosophical Society (TS).

Throughout the past *100*+ years the sole focus for the TOS has been service. In countries around the world, people who have a sense of the oneness of all life and who are motivated to serve, have come together to work toward the alleviation of suffering.

As an international organization, service projects vary from country to country.

In the Philippines, for example, the TOS operates the Golden Link College which offers theosophical education from preschool through the university level.



What We Do in the USA

Our members serve by working individually or through local TOS groups in their local areas. We also join with other TOS groups worldwide to help with humanitarian projects internationally, and we support the programs of other service organizations working in areas of ecology, healing, peace, family, social services, animals and arts and music.

Current Projects Include:

- Fundraising for the **Golden Link College** in Manila, Philippines. Over 85% of the school's students need tuition assistance. Each year donations have been matched by a generous \$20,000 grant from the Kern Foundation.
- Continuing our support for children and families of the Rosebud Native American Reservation, one of the most disadvantaged communities in our nation. The TOS provides holiday gifts for the families and school supplies as well as refurbished computers for
- Awarding scholarships to Native American students at the Oglala Lakota College School of Nursing.

- Promoting a national effort to provide necessary items for the homeless: socks, snacks and water, hygiene items, resource guides and encouragement.
- Granting funds to several **animal rescue organizations**.
- Making seed money and other support available to our local groups for service

projects such as:

- Providing meals for the homeless through the year and providing gift baskets during the holiday season
- Packing items for food drives
- Educating the public about the dangers of plastic and environmental waste
- Assisting at local animal shelters
- Providing copies of War and the Soul, a Quest book, to veterans' organizations
- Providing Theosophical Society in America (TSA) memberships for the incarcerated enrolled in our TS Correspondence Prison Program.
